ABSTRAK

Data rekapitulasi program KB Puskesmas Muara Lembu menunjukkan bahwa jumlah akseptor KB IUD masih sangat jauh dari target Puskesmas terhadap cakupan penggunaan KB IUD yang setidaknya mencapai 50%. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menganalisis manajemen pelayanan kontrasepsi IUD di Puskesmas Muara Lembu Kabupaten Kuantan Singingi tahun 2024. Jenis penelitian yang digunakan pada penelitian ini adalah penelitian deskriptif kualitatif yang dilakukan melalui wawancara dan observasi. Informan dalam penelitian ini adalah Kepala Puskesmas, penanggung jawab program KB, dan akseptor KB IUD. Hasil penelitian ini yaitu (1) Pelayanan KB di Puskesmas Muara Lembu mencakup kegiatan konseling, pemeriksaan kesehatan dan pemasangan kontrasepsi; (2) Perencanaan kegiatan program KB di Puskesmas Muara Lembu adalah berdasarkan target dan pencapaiannya; (3) SDM pelaksana serta sarana prasarana pelayanan KB sudah tersedia lengkap dan memadai; (4) Pemantauan dan evaluasi pelaksanaan program KB di Puskesmas Muara Lembu adalah dengan melihat ketercapaian target akseptor KB dan pemantauan setelah pemasangan IUD. Maka, dapat disimpulkan bahwa secara keseluruhan manajemen pelayanan KB di Puskesmas Muara Lembu Kabupaten Kuantan Singingi sudah baik. Akan tetapi tetap disarankan agar Puskesmas dapat meningkatkan perencanaan, pelaksanaan dan evaluasi pelayanan KB dengan sebaik mungkin agar dapat menemukan inovasi baru terkait peningkatan akseptor IUD.

ABSTRACT

Data from the recapitulation of the Muara Lembu Community Health Center's family planning program shows that the number of IUD family planning acceptors is still very far from the Puskesmas' target for coverage of IUD family planning use, which is at least 50%. This research aims to analyze the management of IUD contraceptive services at the Muara Lembu Community Health Center, Kuantan Singingi Regency in 2024. The type of research used in this research is qualitative descriptive research conducted through interviews and observations. The informants in this research were the Head of the Community Health Center, the person in charge of the family planning program, and the IUD family planning acceptor. The results of this research are (1) Family planning services at the Muara Lembu Community Health Center include counseling activities, health checks and contraceptive installation; (2) Planning for family planning program activities at the Muara Lembu Community Health Center is based on targets and achievements; (3) Implementing human resources and infrastructure for family planning services are complete and adequate; (4) Monitoring and evaluating the implementation of the family planning program at the Muara Lembu Community Health Center is by looking at the achievement of the target for family planning acceptors and monitoring after IUD installation. So, it can be concluded that overall the management of family planning services at the Muara Lembu Community Health Center, Kuantan Singingi Regency is good. However, it is still recommended that Community Health Centers can improve planning, implementation and evaluation of family planning services as best as possible in order to find new innovations related to increasing IUD acceptors.
