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**Hubungan Pengetahuan Dengan Kecemasan Perawat Selama Masa
Pandemi Covid-19 Di Rumah Sakit Santa Maria Pekanbaru**

ABSTRAK

Latar Belakang: Kecemasan akan keselamatan pribadi perawat saat bekerja merupakan hal yang wajar dialami oleh perawat karena apabila mereka tertular, bukan hanya cemas terhadap kesehatan dirinya sendiri, tetapi perawat juga cemas akan menularkan virus Covid-19 kepada keluarga lainnya terutama yang memiliki kelompok rentan seperti bayi dan lansia. **Tujuan:** Mengetahui hubungan pengetahuan dengan kecemasan perawat selama pandemi Covid-19 di Rumah Sakit Santa Maria Pekanbaru. **Metode:** Jenis penelitian kuantitatif korelatif dengan pendekatan *cross sectional*. Proses penelitian mulai bulan Januari 2021 - Juni 2021. Sampel berjumlah sebanyak 36 perawat yang diambil dengan teknik *total sampling*. Kuesioner menggunakan *visual analoge scale*. Uji data yang digunakan yaitu *chi-square*. **Hasil penelitian:** Separuh responden berusia 26-35 Tahun (Dewasa Awal) sebanyak 18 orang (50,0%), hampir seluruh responden berjenis kelamin perempuan sebanyak 34 orang (94,4%), hampir seluruh responden tingkat pendidikan DIII sebanyak 29 orang (80,6%) dan hampir separuh responden masa kerjanya 1-5 tahun sebanyak 16 (44,4%). Gambaran pengetahuan seluruh responden mempunyai pengetahuan baik sebanyak 36 (100%). Gambaran kecemasan responden separuh responden “Cemas Sedang” yaitu sebanyak 24 orang (66,7%). Hasil uji *chi-square* menunjukkan nilai P value $0,028 < \alpha 0,05$ sehingga H_0 di tolak yang berarti ada hubungan tingkat pengetahuan dengan tingkat kecemasan perawat selama covid-19 di RS Santa Maria Pekanbaru. **Rekomendasi:** disarankan pada peneliti selanjutnya untuk meneliti faktor lain yang berhubungan dengan kecemasan perawat selama covid-19.

ABSTRACT

Background: Anxiety about nurses' personal safety while working is a natural thing experienced by nurses because if they are infected, they are not only worried about their own health, but nurses are also worried about transmitting the Covid-19 virus to other families, especially those who have vulnerable groups such as babies and the elderly. Objective: To determine the relationship between knowledge and nurse anxiety during the Covid-19 pandemi at Santa Maria Hospital Pekanbaru. Methods: The research design used is correlation with cross sectional approach. The research process starts from January 2021 - June 2021. The sample in this study was a nurse who served in the Covid-19 isolation room at Santa Maria Hospital Pekanbaru, totaling 36 people taken with a total sampling technique. The questionnaire uses the Visual Analogue Scale. The data test used is Chi-Square. The results: Half of the respondents aged 26-35 years (Early Adults) were 18 people (50.0%), almost all respondents were female as many as 34 people (94.4%), almost all respondents with DIII education level were 29 people (80, 6%) and almost half of the respondents worked 1-5 years as many as 16 (44.4%). The description of knowledge of all respondents have good knowledge as much as 36 (100%). The description of the anxiety of the respondents, half of the respondents were "Medium Anxiety" as many as 24 people (66.7%). The results of the Chi-square test show a P value of $0.028 < 0.05$ so that H_0 is rejected, which means that there is a relationship between the level of knowledge and the level of anxiety of nurses during COVID-19 at Santa Maria Hospital, Pekanbaru. Recommendation: it is recommended for further researchers to examine other factors related to nurse anxiety during covid-19.
